FRASCNA Subcommittee Local Service Report Flyers: Nick B – Handed out 161 (including 10 to Levi and Dan E) has 39 left. He needs volunteers to go with him. He stated that generally more than one person needs to be present during introduction. He checks status of tabs on previously placed flyers. Hospitals are most difficult to get around permission. Libraries are good locations. Outreach: Aledia R covering for Britt B. David suggested we make changes to next questionnaire issued. He stated that 2 meetings he assisted in completing had problems understanding all the questions. Rhonda suggested future questionnaires be shorter. Aleida suggested they be issued twice a year. Nick would like to be included in Blanchester visits to Clean by Candlelight on Mondays. Rhonda brought up need for trusted servants at The War is Over as 2/23 is her last day. Phone lines :Willie nominated as chair - not present. Nick said there were 5 missed calls. He spoke with 2 or 3 of them. One was from Eaton of a Grandmother requesting information for her Grandson. Usually average 3-5 calls per month Policy: Joe not present. Unsure of status of policy committee. There was no meeting being held on 3rd Saturday at St. George's Episcopal Church when Rhonda opened The War is Over at 6:00 PM. H&I: Aleida R – We did not attend women's Greenleaf due to ID issues. Men's was not attended. Purchased and organized new boxes for both women and men with inventory sheet enclosed. She would appreciate being advised prior to area when inventory is needed. Dan E has 3 months clean and is willing to step up in any position qualified for and that is needed. He stated addicts on messenger have requested a meeting at men's treatment center of Massey House in Belfast Area. Also looking to bring a meeting to Highland County Jail in Hillsboro for both women and men. This is being proposed at another area and they are testing our willingness. Jason has been attempting at jail for a while. David suggested our public relations make some calls to determine feasibility, requirements and schedule then we can determine participants. Jason has contacts to jail and to get to Jen P. Aleida suggested we handle the jail and the other proposed area handle the Massey House. We are tabling treatment center and moving forward on the jail. There were discussions regarding how meetings are handled. David said there must be at least 2 attendees at each meeting. There is a panel leader and panel members. The panel leader is the contact person and is required to have 1 year clean and responsible to report to Aleida at least verbally once a month to report any issues or literature needs. There are no specified clean time requirements for panel members. Rhonda brought up the need for sober support at Woodhaven. She will look in to requirements for both male and female relating to rules governing bringing patients to outside meetings such as allowance of children to be present and if prior employees of Woodhaven are permitted to participate. PR:Jen P – Sent emails to 2 places and has not heard back. Will try again this month. Last month Dunbar Rehabilitation Nursing Home and Women's Recovery were proposed. She has updated her copy of the schedule and it is no longer a unity schedule and it now includes phone number lines. Aleida asked that Stepping Out be added to next schedule as it is an active meeting. Aleida stated that if at least some type of representative from a meeting does not attend 3 area meetings in a row they will be remove from the schedule.

LSC requesting: \$65.00 for rent, and \$27.35 for schedules. Also \$85.00 reimbursement to literature chair for Hnl. LSC also asks that nomination form for vote of confidence be added to April 2019 minutes.
