FRASCNA MEETING

28 January 2018

Greetings Five Rivers Family,

We last met last Saturday, 1/20, at the Hope Hotel where the remainder of our meetings will be held until the convention in May. Our closing treasury balance for the meeting was \$7,641.01. We discussed meeting every 2 weeks as we are approaching the 4 month window to the convention. We have decided to maintain our current monthly meeting until such time as we feel additional meetings may be necessary to complete business. We are getting close to identifying our out-of-state speakers, and selecting vendors and a taping contract. Auditions for in-state speakers are still being accepted until 15 February. We have an initial layout for the placement of workshops, etc., and it looks pretty simple and smooth. On-Line registration is available through Pay Pal. Please remember, you will still need to book a hotel room separately through the hotel. Hotel registration is not available through NA website locations. Fundraisers hosted by various areas are beginning to pop up across the state, including our own Fiver Rivers Area chili cook off on 10 Feb. Events are coming in on the same dates so we are identifying representatives to attend these as we receive them. Never Alone Group hosted a fundraiser before their meeting on Jan 13. Attendance for the event and meeting was over 100. Food was excellent and proceeds from the event totaled \$903. Our thanks to all involved. A TV raffle was approved and is being set up with more information to come soon. Our next OCNA sponsored fundraiser, the 10 March basketball tournament, is still scheduled as planned although a change occurred in the subcommittee. Last week we discussed operational concerns about the Fundraising and Entertainment subcommittee which lead to our Subcommittee Chair stepping down. We would like to thank Marissa P. for her service. Fortunately, our very own Stephanie B. was elected to assume the open position immediately. We welcome Stephanie and are extremely confident that she will perform the duties of the position and no further concerns will arise.

A final comment to clear up the topic of the Fundraising and Entertainment subcommittee and issues addressed. There was no evidence of any loss, theft, or misappropriation of funds involved. The motion that



passed last month to send additional donations from this area to the convention was not to cover for any perceived shortage of funds but was simply a request that we, as the hosting area, step out and do a little more than any non-hosting area would do. We are tracking, financially, well within line with previously successful conventions and when assessed separately by the OCNA Advisory Committee Chair, was found to be accurate.
