The literature site has been updated with the current inventory amount for each item. You will also notice improved organization in both item names and the categories they are present in. IPs, for instance, are now ordered by IP number. Additionally, we have increased prices to match World pricing, but have lowered our area shipping and handling fees. This results in a zero net increase in cost to the groups, still provides a discount to groups for ordering through area, and allows the literature committee to better track prices from World.
