C) Alternate RCM Report 8-25

Hello family. Thank you once again for the opportunity to be of humble and gracious service to NA and the Five Rivers Area. It is a true honor to give back.

Multi-Regional Service-Learning Days in Racine, Wisconsin are in 3 weeks, from September 13-15, 2019. We have a total of 3 addicts going from the Five Rivers Area at this time. There is still room for more. We are able to include at least 3 more men and am unsure of how many more women's lodging spaces are available at this time. Please let me know if yourself, or a fellow addict you know, is interested in going to this great event to learn & share how service can enhance your recovery and to bring the message from around the country back to this area, and all its meetings, on attracting others to service in NA so that we may continue to carry the message to the still suffering addict by having all our service positions filled at every level of recovery, from the group to the world service levels. I have reserved the room sponsored by the Five Rivers Area, as well as the transportation vehicle per the motion that was passed at last month's area. All receipts will be submitted at September area meeting once all transactions are finalized and complete.

The Ohio Region elects its trusted servants in July. Currently our RCM and RCM-alternate positions are a 2-year commitment from December to December. I am submitting a motion to amend policy to have the 2-year commitment for these positions run from July to July as well. The reason for this is that an addict cannot serve as an RCM as well as a trusted servant at the Regional level due to conflict of interest. This will allow addicts from our Area to be considered for any Regional positions without this time discrepancy causing a delay in ability to serve.

Policy: Alex H – Absent

Public Relations – Jen P ordered 350 schedules. Reached out to Lebanon prison about the rules to go in. She spoke with Connie at the prison and is currently awaiting a response back. Eric has been working with Connie and is approved to go in. Eric can chair a meeting and bring in a person two times before they have to do the paperwork to get approved. It takes about 3 months to get the paperwork approved for the prison. The person can't be on probation or parole. David spoke with Dayton PR and we were invited to go to the FOA on 25 Aug 19 in downtown Dayton. We would go and hand out schedules for FRASNA. Kyle printed 150 flyers to take there. Last year 150 flyers were handed out. Dayton is willing to work with us and give us more contacts. We discussed who can go to the FOA event. It is from 3pm to 6pm and Tammy is in charge. Willy said he can go there first at 3pm and then David and Helen will go down there after the Area meeting is completed. We voted on the event and everyone agreed.

Outreach: Sandy – Sandy went to a few different meetings on the schedule. She is trying to find people or meetings that need support. She is looking into Blanchard to see if we need to keep them on the schedule. Meeting is called better red than dead. Contact for meeting is Cody. Helen went to the meeting, which meets on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturday. Going to see if they meet regularly, and if they don't meet for 3 months, the meeting will be closed. Trying to make sure all meetings on schedule are meeting regularly, and seeing if they need support. Sandy got handbook with info for outreach program. Sandy is going to work on going to other meetings on the schedule to make sure they are still meeting and make sure the schedule is accurate. Britt gave Sandy folder with some info she was working on.

Phone Lines: Willy – Had four phone calls last month. Willy returned the calls of the other three. Two of those hung up when he returned the call and one didn't answer. One was already contacted back by Helen and they were given the information they needed. Willy reviewed the phone line handbook. Helen, Diana, Aleida, and Willy are the four members on the phone line. Willy needs to learn how to work Google Voice. Only Jen and David G know how to do it. Plan is to contact four people on the phone line to make sure Willy can see who contacted who, and we can be organized so that a report can be made on who was contacted and what they said. This will be done by the next LSC.

Website: Britt – Britt is trying to learn everything that goes into managing the website. She is getting in touch with Dan so that she can get familiar with the website and fully take over the program. Kyle will send Britt the flyers to put on the website. The flyers were sent.

Flyers: Nick B – We need to print 25-30 more flyers. Justin and Kelly still have 18. Nick has 13. Willy talked about helping Nick hand out flyers. Nick handed out 7 flyers last month. Kyle is willing to help make a schedule and organize all the locations visited, that way we can see when, where, and how many flyers were placed. We can also better keep track of the number of flyers made and handed out. Kyle is getting with Nick about making the flyers stick out more.

H and I: Aleida – Aleida was not here but sent David a report. Men and women can go to Greenleaf. Talked about going to Full Circle Wednesday at 7pm, which is a co-ed facility. We are waiting on the final ok from Scott. Full Circle wanted us to go on the weekend, but David wanted to do it during the week. Once Scott contacts David back, we can start going in to the facility on Wednesdays at 7pm. It was voted on and approved by the committee. Aleida is the point of contact. Paul volunteered to be the panel leader. We need to figure out all the rules. David and Aleida will go in first. Paul will get co-ed members to go in. We voted on going in to Lebanon. The committee approved going in to Lebanon prison and providing literature. Jason is interested in going into Highland County Jail. People have already been going in, but wants the blessing of the committee to go in and be a panel leader. Not sure if he will fully represent NA program. He will be at the LSC meeting next month to see if we can add Highland County to our area. We will discuss next month.
