Sunday of each month.

PR: Jen P (Email) - "I called and left messages with Brightview and VOA about literature and H&I. If I don't hear

back this week, I will try them both again. I updated and ordered 250 schedules, which should be ready in the

next couple days." David – Following up on 5 treatment centers. Grandview psyc ward does not remember H&I

ever being there. Access waiting on return call. Full Circle waiting for hospitalization to get off ground and

tornados destroyed some of their transitional housing. This is fact finding mission to determine if it will be PR or

H&I and what they have or what they need. David working with DASNA vice chair. Aleida suggests we attend

DASNA's next H&I meeting.

Outreach: Britt B – Of the 7 meetings which was previously concerned about, 5 are no longer of concern. She

hopes she did not state that she would be attending all 7. Serenity by Candlelight has been closed. Primary

Purpose (Wednesday in Xenia) needs support and has open service positions. Better Read than Dead still

open. Will not be able to attend area the rest of this year. Will be present for LSC meetings. With her

employment schedule is able to serve as Website chairperson on the road. Tallied results of the area

inventory. Needs a committee not one person to create a new area inventory. Rhonda suggest break down into sections and submit one section every 3-4 months to the meetings for completion. The issue was tabled.

Britt holds the outreach position through July but will still show up and help as can. New sober living in Hillsboro, New Life Behavior Ministries, not open yet asked that someone come in and teach them how to work steps, possibly bring books. David said this is PR to have their needs researched and compared to our abilities. David said area minutes are being confused using name form but not changing date and there has been some confusion as to attendance of meetings being in jeopardy of being removed from schedule. Britt stated her concern about a non-existent meeting being listed when an addict in crises may make great pains to get to a meeting in dire need and the meeting be closed resulting in the addict going back out.

Flyers: Nick B – 5 left, passed out 175, gave 20 to Kelly and Justin who passed out 2. Justin helping organize a list of facilities passed out with dates. Nick did not know he was supposed to note dates. He will start dating them now and note the dates on previous locations when he checks on them. Aleida suggests the list be put on the drive. Nick needs to print more flyers and can do for free. Aleida suggests he get them printed for free for his personal use then donate them to NA. There was debate on how to handle someone who is assisting him with flyers who has relapsed, is still attending meetings and still working with a sponsor. It was discussed as to if there is a clean time requirement to participate, to post flyers, the locations clean time requirements, and to represent our organization. There was some question as to if we should get flyers back from this person. Aleida said only Nick should go to new
