**C) Alternate RCM Report 9-22**

Hello family. It is an honor and privilege to be of service to NA and the Five Rivers Area as your RCM Alternate for the Ohio Region. Thank you for this opportunity.

Multi-Regional Service-Learning Days took place in Racine, Wisconsin last week and Five Rivers was represented by 4 addicts. I have collected all my receipts from the trip and turned them in to account for the \$400 given in advance. I am submitting a request for funds in the amount of \$17.89 to cover most trip related expenses. I forgot to get a receipt for 2 of the highway tolls so I have removed that from my request. I wanted to bring to your attention and explain the rental car receipt. The rental car includes Alamo filling up the last tank of gas for us, as their rate was \$2.40/gallon compared to the going rate of \$2.60-2.90 at the time of car rental. I also was able to rent the car from Dayton airport Alamo through a membership I have at a rate \$34 cheaper than anywhere else, but I had to park my car in airport parking for those days for \$14.85. This ended up in an overall savings of \$21+ for FRASCNA with the discounted rental rate and the included final gas fill up. I returned the car nearly completely empty to maximize the savings.

The MRSLDNA was a great event sharing a lot of information that will be particularly useful for our area and region. I have included a copy of the Planning Basics and Area Planning Tool provided at the event for our Area's use. In regard to the issue that was brought up at our August area meeting regarding the stance of the area on the treatment of members of the opposite sex at meetings, this was a hot topic and I will discuss in open forum.
