I am unable to be at the meeting in person. I was hoping Zoom attendance was an option but didn't see a link on the Area business section of the website. I attended the January Regional meeting but don't have anything significant to report at this time. I will review the minutes and give a better report in February.

Work on OCNA40 (Ohio Convention of Narcotics Anonymous), the 2024 Ohio convention is well under way. As with the 2023 convention, hosted by the Ohio Region, the committee was forced to start later than expected and this makes it extremely hard to plan and pay for the convention. Addicts are being encouraged to register as soon as possible to help cover the cost of the event and as usual Areas are being asked to hold fundraisers as well. I think addicts can get a basic registration package for only \$30 until the end of February (I'm confused by the flyer and have asked for clarification). Banquet tickets are \$50 and other entertainment ideas are being considered including a comedy show and/or dance. I'm attaching a pre-registration flyer with my report. Also, while the convention is hosted by the Buckeye Region this year, this is a state convention.
