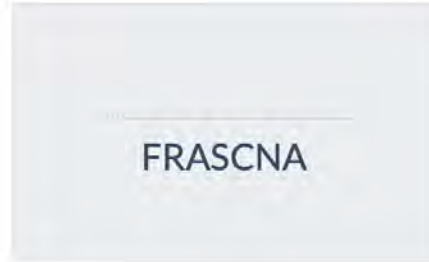

Motion: Update Five Rivers Area Policy section section 5A under Local Services (page 14) to better define and clarify Hospitals & Institutions service positions and responsibilities.

Intent: Clarity positions and responsibilities

Current policy (22Dec2024):

- A. **Hospitals and Institutions (H&I):** Hospitals and institutions subcommittees conduct panels that carry the NA message to addicts who have no other way of hearing our message. Patients at addiction treatment centers, mental health facilities, and therapeutic communities and inmates at jails, prisons, and forensic hospitals. In accordance with the H&I handbook, it is suggested that this area focus on inpatient facilities rather than outpatient facilities to most effectively use area resources ([Per H&I Handbook](#))
- 1) FRASCNA H&I operates as part of the Local Services subcommittee. The H&I Coordinator will attend the Local Services subcommittee meeting each month.
 - 2) H&I Coordinator serves from **July through June** and is selected by the Local Services Committee (not elected by the ASC).
 - 3) It is suggested that the Hospital and Institutions Coordinator have a minimum of (2) years clean time, previous involvement with Area Service, a working knowledge of the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts, and one year of service on the PR/H&I Subcommittee.
 - 4) H&I Coordinator ensures the subcommittee serves in accordance with the H&I Handbook and that Traditions are followed in all contacts with the community.
 - 5) H&I Coordinator maintains a volunteer database and facilitates organization and scheduling of regular H&I meetings.
 - 6) H&I coordinates with PR as needed. To establish relationships with institutions.
 - 7) Coordinator expresses budgetary needs to the Local Services Chair.
 - 8) Coordinator encouraged to attend and report on all Regional H&I meetings. Travel expenses paid by ASC, not to exceed \$120.00.
 - 9) A minimum of (6) months of clean time and strict adherence to presenting NA as suggested in the H&I Handbook is required to enter a facility.
 - 10) A minimum of two recovering addicts of the same gender must be available in order to hold an H&I meeting in a non-co-ed facility.
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Proposed text (22Mar2026):

A. Hospitals and Institutions (H&I): Hospitals and institutions subcommittees conduct panels that carry the NA message to addicts who have no other way of hearing our message. Patients at addiction treatment centers, mental health facilities, and therapeutic communities and inmates at jails, prisons, and forensic hospitals. In accordance with the H&I handbook, it is suggested that this area focus on inpatient facilities rather than outpatient facilities to most effectively use area resources (per H&I Handbook).

1. FRASCNA H&I operates as part of the Local Services subcommittee and includes an H&I Chairperson and (2) Panel Coordinators (one of each gender). The H&I Chairperson will attend the Local Services subcommittee meeting each month.
2. A minimum of two recovering addicts of the same gender must be available in order to hold an H&I meeting in a non-co-ed facility.
3. A minimum of (6) months of clean time and strict adherence to presenting NA as suggested in the H&I Handbook is required to enter a facility.
4. H&I Chairperson:
 - A. Serves from **July through June** and is selected by the Local Services Committee (not elected by the ASC).
 - B. It is suggested that the Hospital and Institutions Chairperson:
 - i. Have a minimum of (2) years clean time.
 - ii. Previous involvement with Area Service.
 - iii. A working knowledge of the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.
 - iv. One year of service on the PR/H&I Subcommittee.
 - C. Chairperson Responsibilities:
 - i. Ensures the subcommittee serves in accordance with the H&I Handbook and that Traditions are followed in all contacts with the community.
 - ii. Periodically contacts facility representatives where meetings are active to maintain lines of communication and determine if facility needs are being met.
 - iii. Maintains a volunteer and facility database.
 - iv. Facilitates training for H&I Panel Members.
 - v. Serves as Panel Coordinator as needed in case of open position.
 - vi. Expresses budgetary needs to the Local Services Chair.
 - vii. Coordinates with PR as needed to establish relationships with institutions.
 - viii. Should attend and report on all Regional H&I meetings. Travel expenses paid by ASC, not to exceed \$120.00.
5. The H & I Panel Coordinator(s):
 - A. It is suggested that Panel Coordinators:
 - i. Have a minimum of (1) years clean time.
 - ii. Previous involvement with Area Service.
 - iii. A working knowledge of the Twelve Steps, Twelve Traditions and Twelve Concepts.
 - iv. Six months of service on the PR/H&I Subcommittee.
 - B. Panel Coordinator Responsibilities:
 - i. Facilitates organization and scheduling of regular H&I meetings.
 - ii. Notifies Chairperson of any issues at meetings.
 - iii. Notifies Chairperson of needs for literature including meeting schedules.
